

2024 HUBS UPDATES

We are overjoyed to share the exciting progress we've made on the construction of our new Hub site since breaking ground in October 2023! Every step forward brings us closer to our vision, and we can't wait to open our doors in 2025.

We're also very excited to announce that we've secured funding for the Coffee Kiosk! The kiosk will operate as a social enterprise, which will help us reinvest directly into Sunalta, funding free programs and events for our community to enjoy. Plus, it will create living-wage jobs and provide valuable training opportunities for local residents!

But that's not all – we're also adding two rental / programming spaces, allowing us to expand our impact and create additional revenue that will further empower our community-driven mission.

As we continue to grow, our team is actively working to secure funding for our commercial kitchen, which will have a positive impact on our community's food security. While we still have a significant amount to raise, we're committed to making this vision a reality!

This new social enterprise is more than just a community initiative – it's a tool of empowerment that will allow us to make an even greater impact in the lives of the people we serve. Together, we're building something truly transformative!







QUANTIFYING OUR IMPACT

In 2024, we were proud to donate over \$28,000 worth of rental space to other non-profits and partner organizations, significantly enhancing our capacity to offer barrier-free programming to the community.

Our partners hosted a variety of programs including; Indigenous drumming, food focused pop-up markets, children's programs, and so much more! This donated space allowed our community access to free and diverse programming, fostering inclusivity and connection to our community!

Our community memberships have grown to an all-time high, with a remarkable 240% increase compared to 2023. This growth highlights the value our residents place on community building.

In 2024 we were able to host over 350 free events, programs, and initiatives, bringing people together and creating spaces for all to engage, learn, and thrive.







QUANTIFYING OUR IMPACT

In 2024, we served over 2,000 people at our Annual Stampede Breakfast, bringing the community together for a celebration of local stampede spirit!

Our resident-led programs saw an incredible 225% increase, reflecting the growing involvement and leadership within our community.

We are so grateful for the dedication of our 180 volunteers, who collectively donated over 1,070 hours of their time in 2024! Their commitment not only helped expand opportunities for resident engagement but also opened doors for more volunteer leadership roles. We are particularly proud to share that one of our first volunteer leaders has now transitioned into a paid staff position with the SCA.

Our operations team continued to dedicate themselves to maintaining our heritage hall and ensuring it remains a safe and welcoming space to gather. Thanks to their efforts, we had no down-time and earned \$96k in rental revenue to support our work in community!

With your help, we launched Sunalta's Culture Night Series, including an Iftar Buffet for Ramadan, an East African Culture Night, and we've already started planning a Lunar New Year event for 2025! The overwhelming response to Culture Nights has shown how much our residents value the opportunity to share rich cultural traditions with their friends and neighbours.
